MR. MUKADDAM APOLOGISES TO MUFTI A.K.HOSEN

In June 2018, a mentally deranged man attacked musallis in a Musjid in Malmesbury, Cape Town.

The attack resulted in the death of one person. On that occasion Mr. Imraan Mukaddam had claimed that Mufti A. K. Hoosen "*had blood on his hands*".

Mr. Mukaddam has now apologized for having slandered Mufti A. K. Hoosen. His apology is reproduced hereunder:

MY APOLOGY TO MUFTI A.K.HOOSEN

I hereby submit my apology to Mufti A.K.Hoosen.

On the 14th of June 2018 following the horrific killing of a close relative in Malmesbury I said amongst other things that Mufti A. K. Hoosen "Has blood on his Hands".

I wish to use this opportunity to express my regret for this statement and hereby retract it without any reservation. I hereby apologize to the learned Scholar for making this remark and I humbly ask his forgiveness for this statement.

The context of my statement was that I was very emotional upon hearing that my cousin was killed after his throat was slit whilst in Itqaaf and two of my nephews were stabbed and injured whilst another person was also killed. I wish to place on record that I retract any inference that Mufti AK Hoosen is in any way connected to the killings in Malmesbury.

I hereby wish to express my regret and once again request Mufti AK Hoosen's forgiveness.

I will post this on a public Statement that I will circulate through all Islamic Media as well as on Deen TV where my original FACEBOOK video was broadcast. The televised proposed apology will also be distributed on my FACEBOOK page where the original statement was made.
