

ALL COMMERCIAL BISCUITS ARE HARAAM

In a letter, BAKERS BISCUITS has confirmed that its TENNIS, LEMON CREAMS AND CHOCKITS biscuits contain alcohol.

Besides alcohol which is haraam, commercial biscuits, not only of Bakers, but of all manufacturers, contain a variety of ingredients such as emulsifier, stabilizer, colourants, flavourings, essences, and ingredients camouflaged with chemical names and E-numbers whose sources are unknown.

At the minimum biscuits with unknown ingredients are *Mushtabah (Doubtful)* from which abstention is necessary.

Biscuits containing alcohol are HARAAM.

It is Waajib for Muslims to abstain from consuming all commercially produced biscuits. Bake your own Halaal-Tayyib biscuits at home thereby saving your *Rooh* from the spiritual poisons of haraam and mushtabah.
