ASSAULT AT THE PIETERMARITZBURG EIDGAH

Question

ANSWER

“Abusing a Muslim (i.e. using vulgar language at him) is fusooq (flagrant and immoral sin), and to fight with him is kufr.”

Thus, on the basis of the businessman's own version in which he proudly claims to have beaten up the Maulana, he has committed ***kufr***.

Besides him confessing to this *kufr*, he has acquitted himself with extreme arrogance, ignorance and pride. He has struggled like a madman to convey the satanic idea that the Deeni institutions (Madaaris and Madaaris) in Pietermaritzburg are operating on the strength and goodwill of men of his ilk. He has childishly and stupidly laboured to create the idea that without the money of the businessmen, the Works of Allah Azza Wa Jal cannot operate.
